

# Inheritance for the son

1. Inheritance: Destruction of rewards that were not valued:

**Revelation 21:8 (NKJV)**  
8 But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their **part** in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

What grace teaches is that Jesus Christ paid the penalty for every sin, so that sin is no longer the issue when it comes to our eternal relationship with God.  
Continual sin in the post-salvation life of the believer represents a failure to grow.  
There are consequences if the believer is living out of fellowship the majority of the time.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11 (NKJV)  
9 Do **you** not know that the unrighteous **will not inherit the kingdom of God?** Do not be deceived. Neither **fornicators**, nor **idolaters**, nor **adulterers**, nor **homosexuals**, nor **sodomites**, **10 nor thieves**, nor **covetous**, nor **drunkards**, nor **revilers**, nor **extortioners** will **inherit the kingdom of God**.

Be clear, be knowledgeable, be precise in your understanding

3238 μέρος (**meros**), acc (part), 10 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 3213; TDNT 4:554—1. LN 33.395 **part**, in contrast to the whole (Lk 15:12; 2Co 3:10)

3368 λοιδορος (**loidoros**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 3060; TDNT 4:393—LN 33.395 **slanderer, verbal abuser** (1Co 5:11; 6:10+)

Noun: adultery | u'ddi-t(u)-ree |  
Extramarital sex that willfully and maliciously interferes with marriage relations +

4523 πόρνος (**pornos**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 3028; TDNT 6:579—LN 33.395 **infamously immoral person, one who commits sexual immorality**

1429 ειδωλολάτρης (**eidōlōlātrēs**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 1429; TDNT 2:379—LN 33.395 **idolater**

3489 μοιχός (**moichos**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 3489; TDNT 4:229—LN 33.395 **adulterer** (Lk 18:11; 1Co 6:9)

3434 μαλακός (**malakos**), 6 (pt), 6v (art)  
adj. : Str 3120—1. LN 79.100 soft, fine, clothing delicate to the touch (Mt 11 8; Lk 7:25+); 2. LN 83 on **homosexual**, passive partner in male-to-male sex act.; male prostitute

788 ἀρσενοκοίτης (**arsenokoitēs**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 733—LN 88.280 **male homosexual**, one who takes the active male role in homosexual intercourse (1Co 6:9), specifically interpreted as male homosexual paedophilia (nab footnote); possibly a more generic term in first Timothy; sodomites (rov, msc, nrb), perverts (nrb, nrb, nrb), practicing homosexuals (nrb), homosexual (nrb) (1Ti 1:10+), note: translations possibly use certain specific terms to refer or allow certain theologues

2. a. What does the term "unrighteous" mean?

ἀδικος (**adikos**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 94—LN 11.20 **unbeliever, unjust person** (Mt 5:45; Lk 18:11; Ac 24:15; 1Co 6:1; 9:1Pw 3:18; 2Pw 2:9)

b. Who are the unrighteous?

Romans 1:29 (NKJV)

29 being filled with **unrighteousness**, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; they are whisperers, **10 nor thieves**, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

1 John 5:17 (NKJV)

17 **All unrighteousness** is sin, and there is sin not leading to death.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11 (NKJV)

9 Do you not know that the **unrighteous** will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, **10 nor thieves**, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. **11 And such were some of you.** But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

Not positional unrighteousness, but rather experiential righteousness unrighteousness; because they were living as if they were not saved.

Corinth was a seaport town. It was known for sexual debauchery and licentiousness to the degree that the term "Corinthian" became a synonym for someone who was a real pervert, and a licentious individual.  
Because they didn't have a Christian value system yet, to tell them these things were wrong, everything was accepted as standard operating procedure.

The Corinthian church that Paul was addressing was:

Self absorbed.  
Proud.  
Anxious.  
Sexually immoral.  
Pagan in their view of the spiritual gifts.  
Drunkards.  
Gluttonous.  
Morally permissive.  
**Not to mention the last in verses 9 & 10**

1 Corinthians 6:1-2 (NKJV)

1 Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the **unrighteous** and not before the **saints**? So the contrast is between the **adikos** and the **saints**.

2 Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world will be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

Paul clearly makes a distinction between the **unrighteousness of the unbeliever**; and the **unrighteousness of the believer**

ἀδικος (**adikos**), au (adv), 6 (pt)  
n.masc. : Str 94—LN 11.20 **unbeliever, unjust person** (Mt 5:45; Lk 18:11; Ac 24:15; 1Co 6:1; 9:1Pw 3:18; 2Pw 2:9)

3 Do you not know that we shall judge angels? How much more, things that pertain to this life?  
4 If then you have judgments concerning things pertaining to this life, do you appoint those who are least esteemed by the church to judge?  
5 I say this to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you, not even one, who will be able to judge between his brethren?  
6 But brother goes to law against brother, and that before unbelievers!  
7 Now therefore, it is already an utter failure for you that you go to law against one another. Why do you not rather accept wrong? Why do you not rather let yourselves be cheated?

ἀδικος (**adikos**), vb. : Str 91; TDNT 1:157—1. LN 20.205 **act, harm** (Lk 10:19; Ac 7:26; 2Pw 2:13; Rev 2:11; 6:6; 7:2; 3:9; 4:10; 19:11:5); 2. LN 88.22 **act, unjustly, do wrong**

8 No, you yourselves **do wrong** and cheat, and you do these things to your brethren!

**adikos** wrongdoers: those who commit experiential wrong, walking as if they are unbelievers

9 Do you not know that the **unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God?** Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, **10 nor thieves**, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

11 And such were **some of you** But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

1 Corinthians 3:4 (NASB95)

4 For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," **are you not mere men?** (walking as)

Ephesians 5:26 (NKJV)

26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the **washing of water by the word**.

Titus 3:7 (NASB95)

7 so that being justified by His grace we would be made **heirs** according to the hope of eternal life.

Galatians 4:7 (NASB95)

7 Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an **heir** through God.

Galatians 3:18 (NASB95)

18 For if the **Inheritance** is based on law, it is no longer based on a promise; but God has granted it to Abraham by means of a promise.

Ephesians 5:5 (NASB95)

5 For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an **Inheritance** in the kingdom of Christ and God.

Colossians 3:23-25 (NASB95)

23 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, **24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the Inheritance** It is the Lord Christ whom you serve. **25 For he who does wrong will receive the consequences of the wrong which he has done, and that without partiality.**

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What all believers have as heir of God—eternal life

1 John 1:9 (NASB95)

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Paul went from the noun ADIKOS to the verb ADIKEO  
\*Instead, you yourselves cheat and are wrongdoers (**ADIKEO** = wrongdoers; experiential wrong), and you do this to your brothers.  
Then in verse 9 he says wrongdoers (those who commit experiential wrong) will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Only some of the group had experienced experiential sanctification
