## 1 Fellowship

## Eternal LIFE

- 1 John 1:1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of **life**—
- 1 John 1:2 the **life** was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that **eternal life** which was with the Father and was manifested to us—
  - **John 1:4** In Him was **life**, and the **life** was the light of men.
  - **John 1:5** And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

Ephesians 5:13 But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light.

Ephesians 5:14 Therefore He says: "Awake, you who sleep, Arise from the dead, And Christ will give you light.

"Isaiah 26:19 Your dead shall live; Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead.

## JESUS EXPOSES SIN

John 15:22 If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin.

John 15:23 He who hates Me hates My Father also.

John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which no one else did, they would have no sin; but now they have seen and also hated both Me and My Father.

John 15:25 But this happened that the word might be fulfilled which is written in their law, 'They hated Me without a cause.'

- 1 John 1:3 that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have **fellowship** with us; and truly our **fellowship** is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.
- 1 John 1:4 And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.
- 1 John 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.
- 1 John 1:6 If we say that we have **fellowship** with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
  - Proverbs 2:9 Then you will understand righteousness and justice, Equity and every good path.
  - Proverbs 2:13 From those who leave the paths of uprightness To walk in the ways of darkness;
  - Proverbs 8:20 I traverse the way of righteousness, In the midst of the paths of justice,

Proverbs 2:20 So you may walk in the way of goodness, And keep to the paths of righteousness. Isaiah 11:3 His delight is in the fear of the Lord, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;

**fellowship:participation-** the act of sharing in the activities or privileges of an intimate association or group; especially used of marriage and churches.

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

2 Corinthians 4:6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Isaiah 9:1 Nevertheless the gloom will not be upon her who is distressed, As when at first He lightly esteemed The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, And afterward more heavily oppressed her, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the Gentiles.

Isaiah 9:2 The people who walked in darkness Have seen a great light; Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, Upon them a light has shined.

Matthew 4:12 Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee.

Matthew 4:13 And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali,

Matthew 4:14 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

Matthew 4:15 "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles:

Matthew 4:16 The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned."

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

The means of their hope had arrived, contrasted with the setting of Ahaz in the old testament and Herod in the new testament , Jesus seen as the Savior - The Light truly would've been seen a light in the midst of darkness

## Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

Ephesians 5:9 (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),

Ephesians 5:10 finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.

- 1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Written to believers
- 1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

John 15:1 "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.

John 15:2 Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

John 15:3 You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

John 15:4 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

John 15:5 "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

John 15:8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

John 15:9 "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

John 15:10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

John 15:11 "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.

- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.
- 1 John 2:2 And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.
- 1 John 2:3 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.
- 1 John 2:4 He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

Romans 8:9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.

Romans 8:10 And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
