As for when for your children's sake, and give them the best opportunity to enjoy the good benefits from the measured senior family members, as late into their teenage years and their 20s, if God permits.

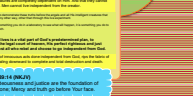
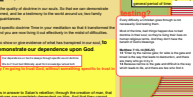
