

By His Knowledge...

Isaiah 53:11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

- Luke 4:1-13 The first part of this chapter tells of Jesus being tempted in the wilderness
- Luke 4:14 Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to **Galilee**, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. Luke 4:15 And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.
 - Isaiah 9:1 Nevertheless the gloom will not be upon her who is distressed, As when at first He lightly esteemed The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, And afterward more heavily oppressed her, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In **Galilee of the Gentiles**.
- Luke 4:16 So He came to **Nazareth, where He had been brought up**. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. Luke 4:17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:
 - *Luke 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; Luke 4:19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."* Very pleasant words to hear
- Luke 4:20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. Luke 4:21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."
- Luke 4:22 *So all bore witness to Him, and marveled at the **gracious** words which proceeded out of His mouth. And they said, "Is this not Joseph's son?"*
 - *What a dynamic motivational speaker! **gracious**: appeal - attractiveness that interests or pleases or stimulates.*
- Luke 4:23 He said to them, "**You will surely say this proverb to Me, 'Physician, heal yourself! Whatever we have heard done in Capernaum, do also here in Your country.'**" Luke 4:24 Then He said, "Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country.
 - Luke 4:25 But I tell you truly, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, and there was a great famine throughout all the land; Luke 4:26 but to none of them was Elijah sent except to Zarephath, in the region of Sidon, to a woman who was a widow. Luke 4:27 And many lepers were in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet, and none of them was cleansed except **Naaman the Syrian**."
- Luke 4:28 So all those in the synagogue, when they heard these things, were filled with wrath, Luke 4:29 and rose up and thrust Him out of the city; and they led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city was built, that they might throw Him down over the cliff. Luke 4:30 Then passing through the midst of them, He went His way.
 - Then Jesus went back to Galilee and ministered more extensively
- Luke 4:42 Now when it was day, He departed and went into a deserted place. And the crowd sought Him and came to Him, and tried to keep Him from leaving them; Luke 4:43 **but He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent."** Luke 4:44 And He was preaching in the synagogues of Galilee.
 - 2 John 2 because of the truth which abides in us and will be with us forever: 2 John 3 Grace, mercy, and peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.
 - It was for the dissemination of the truth that Jesus was sent dissemination: the act or process of disseminating or spreading something : the state of being disseminated

- John 10:14 I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own. John 10:15 As the Father knows Me, even so I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep.
