- 1 Samuel 14:25-32 (NKJV)
- ²⁵Now all the people of the land came to a forest; and there was honey on the ground.
- ²⁶And when the people had come into the woods, there was the honey, dripping; but no one put his hand to his mouth, for the people feared the oath.
- ²⁷But Jonathan had not heard his father charge the people with the oath; therefore he stretched out the end of the rod that was in his hand and dipped it in a honeycomb, and put his hand to his mouth; and his countenance brightened.
- ²⁸Then one of the people said, "Your father strictly charged the people with an oath, saying, 'Cursed is the man who eats food this day.' " And the people were faint.

 unskilled (2 Ti 3:16), rejoices the lover of truth, strengthens the desponding (Ls 184; 84.6), provides permanent principles of conduct, and by God's
 grace brings a rich reward.
