Glory: state - a state of high honor.

2 Peter 1:16-18 (NKJV)

16For We did not follow cunningly devised fables when We made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

17. For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

declared: to cause to know

name: person/name - any rational entity (human being, God) understood by their name; perhaps understood according to the **reputation** and **character** of the person.

Ephesians 1:4-6 (NKJV)

4. just as He **chose** us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love.

- 5. having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will.
- 6. to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

- 12. No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.

testify: to testify approvingly - to offer firsthand authentication in favor or in affirmation of someone.

- 4. Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious,

rejected: to be disapproved of - to be considered bad, wrong, unfit.

Chosen: selected (by someone) in preference to another (or others).

Precious: worth-of high worth or cost. valuable/honored

Coming: to approach - to move towards or near. Seek association with; agree with
