Ephesians 1:11–12 (NKJV)

11 **In Him** also we have obtained an inheritance, **being predestined according to the purpose** of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

12 that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.

In Christ we have a predestined outcome

Ephesians 1:13–14 (NKJV)

13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is the **guarantee** of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

Romans 8:12–17 (NKJV)

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors—not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh.

13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” 16 **The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ**, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

1 John 3:18–20 (NKJV) 18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, **but in deed and in truth**. 19 **And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him**. 20 For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.

2 Corinthians 5:5 (NKJV)

5 Now He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who also has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.

2 Corinthians 1:21–22 (NKJV)

21 Now He **who establishes** us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, 22 who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

who establishes : to strengthen - solidify - to strengthen a **personal quality or aspect; conceived of as making something solid or more solid**

not a personal quality of the old man but of the new

Acts 20:32 (NKJV)

32 “So now, brethren, I commend you to God **and to the word** of His grace, which is able **to build you up** and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Romans 5:1–2 (NKJV)

Hebrews 9:13–15 (NKJV)

13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh,

14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

15 **And for this reason** He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, **that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.**
