The Vision of Faith is Eternal

Hebrews 11:1 - 3 (NKJV)

- 1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- 2 For by it the elders obtained a good testimony.
- 3 By faith we understand that the Worlds (ages) were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

Hope implies - it looks to the future

Hebrews 1:2 (NKJV)

- 2 has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the Worlds;
- 2 Peter 2:5 (NKJV)
- 5 and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

Genesis 5:32 (NKJV)

- 32 And Noah was five hundred years old, and Noah begot Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Genesis 7:6 (NKJV)
- 6 Noah was six hundred years old when the floodwaters were on the earth.

Genesis 9:28 (NKJV)

28 And Noah lived after the flood three hundred and fifty years.

Hebrews 11:8-10 (NKJV)

- 8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.
- 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise;
- 10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.
 - Abraham dwelt among people he did not descend from. they were not the people he originated from.
 - He waited not for temporal city, but an eternal city which has as its foundation a system of truths laid down by God
- 2 Peter 3:14 18 (NKJV)
- 14 Therefore, beloved, looking forward to these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless; Ephesians 5:25-27 (NKJV)
 - 25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,
 - 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.
- 15 and consider that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation—as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you,
- 16 as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction, as

they do also the rest of the Scriptures.

17You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked;

18but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.
