

1 Chronicles 10:13–14 (NKJV)

13 So Saul died for his unfaithfulness which he had committed against the Lord, because he did not keep the word of the Lord, and also because he consulted a medium for guidance.

14 But he did not inquire of the Lord; therefore He killed him, and turned the kingdom over to David the son of Jesse.

1 Chronicles 13:1–4 (NKJV)

1 Then David consulted with the captains of thousands and hundreds, and with every leader.

2 And David said to all the assembly of Israel, "If it seems good to you, and if it is of the Lord our God, let us send out to our brethren everywhere who are left in all the land of Israel, and with them to the priests and Levites who are in their cities and their common-lands, that they may gather together to us;

3 and let us bring the ark of our God back to us, for we have not inquired at it since the days of Saul."

4 Then all the assembly said that they would do so, for the thing was right in the eyes of all the people.

1 Chronicles 14:1–2 (NKJV)

1 Now Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and cedar trees, with masons and carpenters, to build him a house.

2 So David knew that the Lord had established him as king over Israel, for his kingdom was highly exalted for the sake of His people Israel.

1 Chronicles 15:11–15 (NKJV)

11 And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites: for Uriel, Asaiah, Joel, Shemaiah, Eliel, and Amminadab.

12 He said to them, "You are the heads of the fathers' houses of the Levites; sanctify yourselves, you and your brethren, that you may bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel to the place I have prepared for it.

13 For because you did not do it the first time, the Lord our God broke out against us, because we did not consult Him about the proper order."

14 So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the ark of the Lord God of Israel.

15 And the children of the Levites bore the ark of God on their shoulders, by its poles, as Moses had commanded according to the word of the Lord.

1 Chronicles 16:34 (NKJV)

34 Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

1 Chronicles 12:19–22 (NKJV)

19 And some from Manasseh defected to David when he was going with the Philistines to battle against Saul; but they did not help them, for the lords of the Philistines sent him away by agreement, saying, "He may defect to his master Saul and endanger our heads."

20 When he went to Ziklag, those of Manasseh who defected to him were Adnah, Jozabad, Jediael, Michael, Jozabad, Elihu, and Zillethai, captains of the thousands who were from Manasseh.

21 And they helped David against the bands of raiders, for they were all mighty men of valor, and they were captains in the army.

22 For at that time they came to David day by day to help him, until it was a great army, like the army of God.

Psalm 103:21 (NKJV)

21 Bless the Lord, all you His hosts, You ministers of His, who do His pleasure.

hosts = army, military horde

Psalm 103:17–18 (NKJV)

17 But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children,

18 To such as keep His covenant, And to those who remember His commandments to do them.

Psalm 100:5 (NKJV)

5 For the Lord is good; **His mercy is everlasting**, And His truth endures to all generations.

Psalm 106:1 (NKJV)

1 Praise the Lord! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

Psalm 107:1–3 (NKJV)

1 Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His **mercy** endures forever.

2 Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,

3 And gathered out of the lands, From the east and from the west, From the north and from the south.

mercy = goodness Psalm 107:8 (NKJV)

8 Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His **goodness**, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!

Psalm 107:15 (NKJV)

15 Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!

Psalm 107:21 (NKJV)

21 Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
 Psalm 107:31 (NKJV)
 31 Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
 Psalm 107:43 (NKJV)
 43 Whoever is wise will observe these things, And they will understand the **lovingkindness** of the Lord.

Psalm 118:1-4 (NKJV)

- 1 Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.
- 2 Let Israel now say, "**His mercy endures forever.**"
- 3 Let the house of Aaron now say, "**His mercy endures forever.**"
- 4 Let those who fear the Lord now say, "**His mercy endures forever.**"

Jeremiah 16:14-15 (NKJV)

14 "Therefore behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "that it shall no more be said, 'The Lord lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt.'
 15 but, 'The Lord lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had driven them.' For I will bring them back into their land which I gave to their fathers.

4. **LN 27.55-27.60** (qal) be careful, beware, pay attention, make sure, watch oneself, guard oneself, i.e., **learn or remember information** and take care to watch for dangers (Dt 5:32); (nif) be careful (Ex 23:21);

 6. **27.55** ἀναζώννυμι τὰς ὀσφύας τῆς διανοίας: (an idiom, literally 'to bind up the loins of the mind') to prepare oneself for learning and thinking—to get one's mind ready for action, to be ready to learn and to think, to be alert.' διὸ ἀναζωσάμενοι τὰς ὀσφύας τῆς διανοίας ὑμῶν 'so then, have your minds ready for action' 1 Pe 1:13
1 Peter 1:10-16 (NKJV)

10 Of this salvation the **prophets have inquired and searched carefully**, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,

11 searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

12 To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—**things which angels desire to look into.**

13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14 as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance;

15 but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct,

16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

1 Peter 1:22-25 (NKJV)

22 **Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit** in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,

23 having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,

24 because "All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away,

25 But the word of the Lord endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.

Acts 15:8-9 (NKJV)

8 So God, who knows the heart, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He did to us,
9 and made no distinction between us and them, **purifying their hearts by faith.**

Acts 10:42-43 (NKJV)

42 And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead.

43 **To Him all the prophets witness** that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins.”

Matthew 28:19-20 (NKJV)

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

Isaiah 42:1 (NKJV)

1 “Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

Hosea 6:1-3 (NKJV)

¹ Come, and let us return to the Lord; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up.

² After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.

³ Let us know, **Let us pursue the knowledge of the Lord.** His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth.

Isaiah 53:11 (NKJV)

11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. **By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many,** For He shall bear their iniquities.

Zechariah 13:1-2 (NKJV)

1 “In that day a fountain shall be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness.

2 “It shall be in that day,” says the Lord of hosts, “that I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered. I will also cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to depart from the land.

Luke 19:41-44 (NKJV)

41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it,

42 saying, “**If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace!** But now they are hidden from your eyes.

43 For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side,

44 and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, **because you did not know the time of your visitation.”**
