

A Song of Salvation

Isaiah 26:1-4

1. Subject: Israel's future / Gentile Maturity
2. Objective : Strengthen our resolve

Context: **Vv 1 In that day...** = That great "Day of the Lord" which will begin immediately after "the Rapture of the Church," II Thessalonians, chapter two.

Isaiah 26:1–6 (NKJV)

1 In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; God will appoint salvation for walls and bulwarks."

In that day:

a. **Isaiah 27:2–3 (NKJV)**

2 In that day sing to her, "A vineyard of red wine!"

3 I, the LORD, keep it, I water it every moment; Lest any hurt it, I keep it night and day.

Exodus 15:2-21 (NKJV)

2 The LORD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; He is my God, and I will praise Him; My father's God, and I will exalt Him. ...-21

Numbers 21:16–18 (NKJV)

16 From there they went to Beer, which is the well where the LORD said to Moses, "Gather the people together, and I will give them water."

17 Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well! All of you sing to it—

18 The well the leaders sank, Dug by the nation's nobles, By the lawgiver, with their staves."
And from the wilderness they went to Mattanah,

Judges 5:1–2 (NKJV)

1 Then Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam sang on that day, saying:

2 “When leaders lead in Israel, When the people willingly offer themselves, Bless the LORD!

2 Samuel 22:1–3 (NKJV)

1 Then David spoke to the LORD the words of this song, on the day when the LORD had delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul.

2 And he said: “The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer;

3 The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence.

2 Open the gates, That the **righteous** nation which keeps the truth may enter in.

Isaiah 60:11 (NKJV)

11 **Therefore your gates shall be open continually; They shall not be shut day or night,** That men may bring to you the wealth of the Gentiles, And their kings in procession.

Isaiah 60:18 (NKJV)

18 Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, Neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; **But you shall call your walls Salvation, And your gates Praise.**

Isaiah 62:10 (NKJV)

10 **Go through, Go through the gates!** Prepare the way for the people; Build up, Build up the highway! Take out the stones, Lift up a banner for the peoples!

Psalms 118:19–20 (NKJV)

19 **Open to me the gates of righteousness;** I will go through them, And I will praise the LORD.

20 **This is the gate of the LORD, Through which the righteous shall enter.**

Isaiah 60:21 (NKJV)

21 **Also your people shall all be righteous; They shall inherit the land forever, The branch of My planting, The work of My hands,** That I may be glorified.

3 You will keep him in **perfect peace**, Whose **mind/inclination,attitude** (the thing formed shaped- like clay) is **stayed/rests,established** on You, {**Because** he **trusts/has faith** in You}.

it's the reaction of the thing formed or shaped that's important { choosing to be shaped/formed }

Isaiah 9:6–7 (NKJV)

6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace**.

7 **Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end**, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Isaiah 57:19–21 (NKJV)

19 "I create the fruit of the lips: **Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near," Says the LORD**, "And I will heal him."

20 But the wicked are like the troubled sea, When it cannot rest, Whose waters cast up mire and dirt.

21 "There is no peace," Says my God, "for the wicked."

4 Trust in the LORD forever, For in YAH, the LORD, **is everlasting strength.**

is a Rock of Ages.

5 For He brings down those who dwell on high, The lofty city; He lays it low, He lays it low to the ground, He brings it down to the dust.

b. humility

Isaiah 2:11–12 (NKJV)

11 The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, The haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, And **the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day.**

12 For the day of the Lord of hosts Shall come upon everything proud and lofty, Upon everything lifted up— And it shall be brought low—

Isaiah 2:20–22 (NKJV)

20 In that day a man will cast away his idols of silver And his idols of gold, Which they made, each for himself to worship, To the moles and bats, 21 To go into the clefts of the rocks, And into the crags of the rugged rocks, From the terror of the Lord And the glory of His majesty, When He arises to shake the earth mightily. 22 **Sever yourselves from such a man, Whose breath is in his nostrils; For of what account is he?**

6 The foot shall tread it down— The feet of the poor And the steps of the needy.”
